Mr. Chair,

Distinguished delegates,

I am taking the floor in response to the statement made by the distinguished delegate of Türkiye. At the outset, let me once again call on the Turkish delegation to respect the names of its fellow UN Member States. We demand that as a full member of this forum, our proper name be used.

Furthermore, we wish to make the following remarks:

The international community has no doubts about the sovereignty of the Republic of Cyprus, and the fact that this sovereignty extends over the whole island. A significant part of the territory of Cyprus remains occupied since 1974 and the illegal entity which was established by Türkiye was immediately condemned by the Security Council though its Resolutions 545 (1983) and 550 (1984). The Turkish military occupied part of Cyprus will always remain an integral part of the Republic of Cyprus. To this extend, the statement made by the Turkish delegation is false in substance and unacceptable.

We call on the Turkish delegation to respect the technical character of the UN Session of UNGEGN for the Standardization of Geographical Names, and refrain from any attempts to politicize its works and discussions. We also call on Türkiye to respect the sovereignty, unity, independence, and territorial integrity of the Republic of Cyprus, and to stand by the United Nations Charter.

The reference given by the Turkish delegation regarding document GEGN.2/2023/5/CRP.5 is not relevant to Agenda Item 4(a). As a matter of fact, the sole aspect of the Cyprus problem which is relevant in the context of our work is that Turkiye has illegally and arbitrarily changed over 35,000 geographical names in the occupied area of Cyprus attempting to erase its historical identity and millennia-old character and heritage.
